**N.Year = New Year**    **W = Week**    **M = Month**    **I = Intercalary day (after every 3 months/90 days)**

- **New Year** starts on **Day 4** (every year)  
This is the day that **אֵלֹהִים** (YHWH) created the **sun, moon and stars**. **ONLY the luminaries** are used to determine **signs, appointed times, days and years (Gen 1:14)**
- **Week (52)** of the old year, is also **week (1)** of the **New Year** (starts on **day 4**)
- Each week has a **fixed 7 days cycle**; each **month has 30 days**; **52 weeks a year & 364 days a year**
- There is an **Intercalary day** (change of seasons) **after every 3 months (or 90 days)**
- The **Sabbath-day** remains on a **fixed day of the week** – the **seventh day (Gregorian sat-day)**

- All the **Appointed Times** will be on a **fixed day(s)** every year
- **Months 1, 4, 7 and 10** will always start on **day 4** of the week
- **Months 2, 5, 8 and 11** will always start on **day 6** of the week
- **Months 3, 6, 9, and 12** will always start on **day 1** of the week
- **Pesach (Passover)** will always start on the **evening of day 3** (day 14 of month 1)
- **Unleavened Bread (Matzah)** will always start on **day 4** of the week
- **First Fruits (Bikkurim)** will always be on **day 19** of the first month (1<sup>st</sup> day of the week)
- **Shavu'ot (Pentecost)** will always be on **day 68** of the year (1<sup>st</sup> day of the week)
- **Yom Teruah (Trumpets)** will always start on **day 4** of the week
- **Yom Kippur (Atonement)** will always start on **day 5** of the week (**in the evening**)
- **Sukkot (Tabernacles)** will always **start and end** on **day 4** of the week
- **Unleavened Bread, Yom Teruah and Sukkot** all start on **day 4** of the week
- **First Fruits and Shavu'ot** will always start on **day 1** of the week
- **The Calendar** is **FIXED** every year and **doesn't change**. **No person can alter its fixed patterns**
- NOTE that there are exactly **12 weeks** **between months** in columns of days numbered **1; 4 and 6**

**Scriptural Appointed Time Dates** (for **Gregorian 2017**), confirmed by Scripture.

The **Scriptural/Annual Year** starts on the **fourth day** of the week – every year.  
The **fourth day** of the week (around the time of the (March) Equinox) is . . .  
**Gregorian 22 Mar 2017.**

**22 Mar 2017** will thus be the **start of the next Scriptural Year** (or **Gregorian 2017**).

**Month 1** = 22 Mar - 20 Apr (**30 days**)

**Month 2** = 21 Apr - 20 May (**30 days**)

**Month 3** = 21 May - 20 Jun (**31 days**) includes 1 intercalary day

**Month 4** = 21 Jun - 20 Jul (**30 days**)

**Month 5** = 21 Jul - 19 Aug (**30 days**)

**Month 6** = 20 Aug - 19 Sep (**31 days**) includes 1 intercalary day

**Month 7** = 20 Sep - 19 Oct (**30 days**)

**Month 8** = 20 Oct - 18 Nov (**30 days**)

**Month 9** = 19 Nov – 19 Dec (**31 days**) includes 1 intercalary day

**Month 10** = 20 Dec - 18 Jan (**30 days**)

**Month 11** = 19 Jan - 17 Feb (**30 days**)

**Month 12** = 18 Feb - 20 Mar (**31 days**) includes 1 intercalary day

The year is completed in **EXACTLY 364 days** – **EVERY YEAR** since creation!

**Day 1 of Month 1** of the **NEXT Scriptural Year** will thus commence on **21 Mar 2018**.
