What we wear in relation to our Bodies as a sanctuary of the SPIRIT

- The following is a revelation I believe the Ruach (Spirit) of Almighty Father Yahuah (YHUH) gave me...
- Because the Word of FATHER YAHUAH (YHUH/YHWH) teaches us to REMAIN PURE for marriage, a man and woman should honor and respect their bodies as a sanctuary of YHUH's Spirit, and should therefore **be sensitive to [what] they wear and [how] they wear it!**
- **1Cor 6:19-20** Or do you not know that your **body is the Dwelling Place of the Setapart Spirit** who is in you, which you have from Elohim (Almighty), and <u>you are not your own</u>? For you were <u>bought with a price</u>, therefore <u>esteem Elohim in your body</u> and in your spirit, which are of Elohim.
- From the above scripture, we clearly see that our bodies are sanctuaries and do not belong to us, but to our FATHER, through His SON, by their Spirit. We are thus ambassadors of FATHER through His Ruach (Spirit) wherever we go and whatever we do, including what we wear, and how we look!

What the Ruach of YAHUAH revealed to me with regards to acceptable dress code . . .

- He showed me a picture of a bride (understanding that we are guided to be the PURE BRIDE of Messiah Yahusha (Messiah's True Hebrew Name)). When a Bride marries her Bridegroom, she is properly dressed in a dress that does not place any emphasis on her curves (curves is soft on the eyes of a man — because men are stimulated by what they see). The dress does not show any cleavage and properly covers all of the woman's beautiful curves, including her shoulders, breasts, stomach, and legs. Stomach and naval you might ask? It is the part of the woman's body that connects her breasts and private part — representing the two body parts that men find most attractive and stimulating in a woman. It is also where FATHER chooses to birth new life and is thus precious and set-apart unto Him. A woman who wears any dress or clothing that draws attention to her curves can easily without her knowing it, lead a man to stumble, bearing in mind that men are stimulated by what they see, and the vast majority of men struggle with pornography. The enemy draws the man's attention to the woman's curves by what she wears and places images in his mind of unrighteous behavior. It will most probably lead to sin, adultery, and ultimately death, if not controlled effectively by the Word of ELohim.
- Rom 14:13 Therefore let us not judge one another any longer, but rather judge this, not to put an obstacle or a stumbling-block in our brother's way.
- 1Pe 3:3-5 Your adornment should not be outward arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on dresses but the hidden Man of the heart, with the incorruptible ornament of a meek and peaceable spirit, which is of great value before Elohim. For in this way, in former times, the set-apart women who trusted in Elohim also adorned themselves, being subject to their own husbands.
- Pro 31:30 Loveliness is deceptive And prettiness is vain, A woman who fears יהוה (YHUH) is to be praised.

- Pro 6:25, 27-29 Do not desire her prettiness in your heart, Neither let her captivate you with her eyelids. Would a man take fire to his bosom, And his garments not be burned? Would a man walk on hot coals, And his feet not be scorched? So is he who goes in to his neighbour's wife; None who touches her goes unpunished.
- When a woman is <u>not married</u> to any man and she is in covenant with FATHER YHUH Yahusha {as her Bridegroom} is her husband (they cannot be intimate like a man and woman in the flesh, but are intimate in a pure and deep spiritual/emotional relationship). As long as a woman is <u>unmarried</u>, she should <u>daily submit her dress code</u> to her Bridegroom Yahusha . . . but when she <u>gets married</u> to her HUSBAND, she should submit her dress code to her husband as her body now belongs to him and his body belongs to her (with emphasis on their bodies, not their souls or spirits) . . . her husband should then have the freedom to suggest and/or guide her on her dress code and vice versa, and both should have the freedom to inform the other (in love) when they wear something inappropriate that may lead someone to stumble.
- 1Cor 7:3-5 Let the husband render to his wife what is her due, and likewise also the wife to her husband. The <u>wife</u> does <u>not</u> have authority over her own body, but the husband does. And likewise the <u>husband</u> does <u>not</u> have authority over his own body, but the wife does. Do <u>not deprive</u> one another except with agreement for a time, to give yourselves to fasting and prayer. And come together again so that Satan does not try you because of your lack of self-control.
- Eph 5:22-26 <u>Wives</u>, subject yourselves to your own husbands, as to the Master. Because the husband is head of the wife, as also the Messiah is head of the assembly, and He is Saviour of the body. But as the assembly is subject to Messiah, so also let the wives be to their own husbands in every respect. <u>Husbands</u>, love your wives, as Messiah also did love the assembly and gave Himself for it, in order to set it apart and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word.
- Col 3:18-19 <u>Wives</u>, subject yourselves to your own husbands, as is proper in the Master. Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter toward them.
- **1Pet 3:1-2** In the same way, <u>wives</u>, be subject to your own husbands, so that if any are disobedient to the Word, they, without a word, might be won by the behaviour of their wives, having seen your blameless behaviour in fear.
- Psa 93:5 Your witnesses have been very trustworthy. <u>Set-apartness</u> befits Your house, O יהוה (YHUH), forever.
- Phil 2:13-15 for it is Elohim who is working in you both to desire and to work for His good pleasure. Do all matters without grumblings and disputings, in order that you be blameless and faultless, children of Elohim without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world.
