Messiah's TRUE SCRIPTURAL Name

In this intensive study we will investigate all the different name meanings pertaining to salvation/deliverance in Scripture, including the names [Yeshua], [Yeshuah], [Yahushua] and [Yahusha], and also look at the ending of "shua" for Messiah's Name.

[Yeshua] or [Yahushua] is often taught as the Hebrew word(s) for Yahuah, our Saviour, meaning Yahuah (The Father) saves (through His Son – The Messiah).

Strong's or any Hebrew concordance will show us that [spiritual] <u>salvation/to save</u> is [Yesha] from Hebrew Strong's H3468, which comes from the Hebrew root word [Yasha], which is Hebrew Strong's H3467.

2Sam 22:3 "My Elohim is my rock, I take refuge in Him, My shield and the horn of my *deliverance*(H3468), My high tower and my refuge. My *Saviour*(H3467), You save me from violence.

We will start with the word [Yeshuah] in Scripture . . .

What do the Hebrew Strong's teach about [Yeshua]?

Neh 8:17 And the entire assembly of those who had come back from the captivity made booths and sat under the booths, for since the days of **Yeshua**(H3442) **son of Nun** until that day the children of Yisra'ĕl had not done so. And there was very great rejoicing.

H3442 Yeshua ► Jeshua

If we go to the **WORD ORIGIN** of [Yeshua], we find the following:

Deut 3:21 "And I commanded **Yehoshua**(H3091) at that time, saying, 'Your eyes have seen all that יהוה (YHUH) your Elohim has done to these two sovereigns. יהוה (YHUH) does the same to all the reigns which you are passing over".

H3091 Yehoshua ► "YHUH is salvation," Moses' successor, also the name of a number of Isr.

from Yhvh (which should be Yhuh according to ancient Hebrew) and yasha

The Names [Yeshua] and [Yahushua] are used for all of the following people/places in Scripture:

- **1) Moses' successor**, son of Nun, יְהוֹשׁוּעַ Deut 3:21; Judg 2:7; Exo 17:9,10,13,14 and more . . .
- 2) a Bethshemite 1Sam 6:14,18
- 3) high priest after the restoration, son of Jehozadak Hag 1:1,12,14; Hag 2:2,4; Zech 3:1,3,6,8,9 and more . . .
- 4) governor of Jerusalem under Yosiah 2King 23:8
- 5) head of one of the classes of priests 1Chron 24:11, possibly also Ezra 2:36 and Neh 7:39.
- 6) a Levitical family-name of frequent occurrence: Ezra 2:40; Ezra 3:9; Neh 8:7; Neh 9:4,5; Neh 10:10; Neh 12:8.
- 7) father of a builder at the wall Neh 3:19
- 8) a Judaite family-name Ezra 2:6 = Neh 7:11; 2Sam 22:3
- 9) proper name, of a location in south of Judah Neh 11:26 בְּיֵשׁוּע

NONE of the 9 names listed above are related to [saving] mankind from their [sins], whereas the Hebrew words [ye-sha] and [ya-sha] are related to man's salvation/deliverance.

Now let's have a look at how the Hebrew words [yesha] and [yasha] guide us to the [true] meaning of Messiah's Name – to save, deliver (or salvation).

<u>LXX related word</u> (Hebrew and Greek Strong's) H3467 yasha

What MUST be UNDERSTOOD from a **pure language perspective** is the following VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION . . .

Any **RESTORED SCRIPTURE TRANSLATION** will CONFIRM that **Messiah's NAME** carries <u>five (5) Hebrew letters</u>, **NOT FOUR**, or SIX.

[Yeshua], written as ישׁוּע has ONLY four (4) letters, NOT FIVE.

[Yahushua], written as יְהוֹשׁׁוּעַ has six (6) letters, NOT FIVE (5).

[Yahusha] as the NAME appears in Restored Scripture translations is written as יהושע and carries five (5) letters. The number 5 symbolize [grace]. Doesn't Scripture teach us that we are saved by favour (grace)? Eph 2:5

Let's look at the [shua] ending of Messiah's Name . . .

Hab 1:2 O יהוה, till when shall I <u>cry</u>(H7768), and You not hear? I cry to You, "Violence!" and You do not <u>save</u>(H3467).

H7768 shava ► to cry out (for help)

Yob 30:24 Yet does not one in a heap of ruins stretch out his hand, or in calamity <u>cry</u> <u>out(H7769)</u> for help? H7769 shua ► a cry for help <u>Word Origin</u> from shava(H7768)

Yob 36:19 Would He value your <u>*riches*(H7769 = shua)</u>? No, not precious ore, nor all your strength!

H7770a ► Shua Shua: father of Judah's wife <u>Word Origin</u> from [yasha]

H7770b ► shua

shua: perhaps opulence Short Definition: **riches** <u>Word Origin</u> from [yasha]

H7774 ► Shua Shua: "wealth," an Asherite woman <u>Word Origin</u> from [yasha]

SUMMARY

Upon our study of the words in Scripture teaching about [salvation / deliverance], including the {shua} ending of Ye[shua] and Yahu[shua], we arrive at the following <u>CONCLUSION</u>...

- Yeshuah (H3444) is a *feminine participle* of [yasha]
- Teshuah (H8668) comes from the Hebrew root word [yasha]
- Moshaah (H4190) comes from the Hebrew <u>root word</u> [yasha]
- Yeshua (H3442) is the same as Yahushua (H3091)
- Yahushua (H3091) are a *combination* of The *Father's Name* (YHUH) and [yasha]
- Yesha (H3468) comes from the Hebrew root word [yasha]
- Shua (H7770a; H7770b; H7774) all come from the Hebrew root word [yasha]

<u>ALL the above words</u> in Hebrew points us to the <u>HEBREW ROOT WORD</u> [YA-SHA H3467], <u>pointing us to Messiah's Name</u> - ending with [sha] Yahu-sha, which means Yahuah saves We also see that the <u>Greek word for save</u> (G4982) directly linked to Messiah's Name is <u>RELATED</u> to the Hebrew root word [yasha].

We see the IMPORTANCE of a <u>COMBINATION</u> of the Father's Name and the Hebrew words "Ye-sha" (H3468) and "Ya-sha" (H3467), GUIDING us to the <u>TRUE NAME of</u> <u>Messiah</u>, confirming what Scriptures teach, pertaining to His Name. (see Jer 30:11; Acts 2:21; Rom 10:13 and Yo'el 2:32)

Matt 1:21 "And she shall give birth to a Son, and you shall *call His Name [Yahusha]* יהושע for He shall <u>save(G4982)</u> His people *from their sins*."

If we go to the word "**Yeshu**" (closely related to Yeshua) on the **Free Online Dictionary**, we find the following shocking discovery . . .

Acronym: Yeshu

Definition: Yemach Shemo Vezichro (meaning 'May his name and memory be obliterated'), remembering that it was the Jews (and Romans) who impaled the Messiah and didn't acknowledge Him as the Messiah.

So it can be understood WHY they try to <u>HIDE His Name</u> even to this day!

The above is *confirmed* in Wikipedia under the heading Yeshu:

Christian missionary Kai Kjaer-Hansen points out that its letters correspond to the abbreviation (ו"יש) for the Hebrew expression וזכרו שמו ימח (yimmach shemo vezikhro), meaning "May his name and memory be blotted out"

MESSIAH'S TRUE [HEBREW] NAME, confirmed by Scripture

Scripture teaches us that the <u>FATHER and His Son are ONE</u> (Yohn 17:11, 22)! Scripture also teaches that the <u>Son came IN His Father's Name</u> (Yohn 5:43) and <u>did</u> <u>everything IN His Father's Name</u> (Yohn 10:25) . . .

CONSISTENT with the Father's nature; the **authentic Scriptural Name of His Son is also ROOTED in His own [Set-Apart] Name!**

Scripture CONFIRM that our Messiah's Name was never "Jesus" . . . the Name "Jesus" is less than 500 years old on earth, whilst our Messiah died more than 2000 years ago. His Name was translated from the Hebrew (Yahusha), to the Greek (lesous/lesvs), to the Latin (lesus), to the English (Jesus). Ancient Hebrew is the FIRST and ORIGINAL LANGUAGE of SCRIPTURE as can be proven by many reputable resources. There is NO LETTER "J" in Hebrew or Greek! The name "Jesus" was first introduced to the KJV Translation of the Bible after 1627, NEVER PRIOR to that!

Scriptures teach that anyone who *calls on the Name of YHUH (Yahuah)* will be saved/delivered.

(Yo'el 2:32; Acts 2:21 and Rom 10:13)!

It is thus important to NOTE that the *Scriptural Name of the Messiah will "POINT TO" SALVATION* to align with sound Scriptural teaching.

Our FATHER made His Name (Exo 3:15, Isa 42:8) as well as His Son's Name (Mat 1:21, Luk 1:31) known to us through His Word. *Their Names are ONE as they are ONE* (Yohn 17:11 and 22). The FATHER'S CORRECT SCRIPTURAL NAME in every language on earth is YHUH (Yahuah). There are MUCH Scriptural and Historical EVIDENCE to prove this!

His Son, our *Messiah's Name is IN the FATHER's Name*.

His SCRIPTURAL Name in EVERY LANGUAGE on earth as already proven from the HEBREW STRONG's, is Yahusha The [Yahu] is *in the FATHER's Name* and the [sha] *points to salvation* through the Son, hence you add the "Yahu" and the "sha" and get Yahu sha!

Ma'aseh (Acts 4:12) "And there is no deliverance in anyone else, for there is NO other Name under the heaven given among men by which we need to be saved."

We take the **"YAHU"** (also the *first 3 letters in the FATHER'S Name*), which is demonstrated to be the common pronunciation of "yud-hay-uau(waw)" and the "sha", which is the common pronunciation of "shin-ayin" and we get YAHU-sha... which means **YAHU-ah (the FATHER), saves (sha), through His SON.**

Yod = "Y" (also in the Father's Name) Hay = "ah" (also in the Father's Name) Uau (Waw) = "u" (also in the Father's Name) Shin = "sh" Ayin = "a" (silent sound)

Adding all the letters individually, we get Y-ah-u-sh-a!

So our Messiah's Name is YAHU-sha, which means "YAHU-ah (The Father) saves (sha) through His Son", which is consistent with Scriptural teaching.

MattitYahu (Matthew) 1:21 "She will give birth to a son, and you are to name Him Yahusha, because He will <u>SAVE</u> His people from their sins".

What is also IMPORTANT to note is that <u>Messiah's Name REFLECTS the name of the</u> <u>Tribe from which He came</u>, giving us another confirmation that the "Yahu" in His Name cannot be disputed or argued by anyone who has discernment and proper understanding of Scripture!

YAHU-dah (Judah) is the tribe YAHU-sha is Messiah's Name YAHU-ah is the Father's Name <u>All three</u> carry the Yud-Hay-Uau (YHU) YAHU in their Names!

Our Mashiach (Messiah's) Name is derived from the Hebrew word **Ye**"sha" as already established (H3468) = meaning: deliverance, rescue, salvation, safety and welfare. The Word Ye"sha" comes from the HEBREW ROOT Word Ya"sha" (H3467) = meaning: to deliver and save. You will CLEARLY see that both Ye"sha" and Ya"sha" end with "sha" (not "shua").

What is interesting to note (not taught as Linguistic Truth) as revealed to me (personally) is the fact that <u>several very important words in Hebrew</u> carry the "sha" (Yahu "sha"), directly linked to the Messiah's Name. Bear in mind that the Name of the Messiah is derived from the Hebrew Word Ye"sha" (H3468). Yesha comes from the ROOT word Ya"sha" (H3467). Both these root words <u>end with "sha"</u>.

In the Book of **Ye**"<u>sha</u>"**Yahu** (Isaiah), our Father reveals His Name to us (**Isa 42:8**) and teaches us that there is NO Saviour apart from Him (**Isa 43:11**). In both instances these foundational truths comes from the Hebrew ROOT WORD Ya-sha (H3467), <u>pointing to</u> Messiah Yahu-sha's <u>Name</u>.

I do NOT share this as Linguistic TRUTH, but merely as a personal revelation. "Sha" bat Scriptures teach that Messiah is Master of the Sabbath (Mat 12:8; Mar 2:28; Luk 6:5) "Sha"lom Without our Messiah's redemptive work on the pole/stake/tree, we cannot have Shalom (peace) (Joh 14:27; 16:33). "Sha"ma Hebrew Strong's 8085 meaning to "hear" or "obey" Hear or obey what? -- The Word of ELohim (Exo 15:26; Exo 19:5) "Sha"ar (Hebrew Strong's 8179) Sha'ar means a "gate" or "door" Messiah is the DOOR through which believers must enter to become part of the household of The Father! (Yohn 14:6) "Sha"vuot

Messiah Yahusha perfectly fulfilled the Festival of Shavuot (Pentecost), which is one of the four (seven in total) Appointed Times of Almighty YHUH (YHWH) that He already fulfilled

(Lev 23:16-22; Act 2:1-4)

"Sha"mayim (heaven)

When our Messiah ascended to heaven, He said that He was going to prepare a place for us

(Yohn 14:2-3).

Yeru"sha"layim (Jerusalem)

The city in Scripture that Father YHUH (YHWH) has put His Name and from where Messiah and the set-apart ones will reign (2Ki 21:4; 2Chr 6:6; Jer 3:17; Rev 3:12).

May everyone who have read and studied this teaching intensively be guided by Scripture, the root language of Scripture, and The Ruach of Yahuah - and NOT by man.
